Class Hours

Summer program classes begin at 9 a.m. and conclude at 3 p.m. Before and after care is available. Morning care is available at 7:30 a.m. and afternoon care begins at 3 p.m. and concludes at 6 p.m.

Late fees are charged beginning at 6:01 p.m.

Summer Program Teachers and Staff

Our summer program teachers are certified teachers who work at Matheia School during the school year.

How to Register

Pick up a registration form at Matheia School or e-mail a request for a registration form (matheia@yahoo.com) Return the form with full payment to the above address. Full payment for all summer sessions is due upon registration. There is a one-time registration fee of \$25.00.

Class Size

Each week must have a minimum enrollment of 9.

Refund Policy

Refunds are given when we must cancel a camp. A camp may be cancelled due to lack of enrollment. The decision to cancel a camp due to lack of enrollment is made on May 30th, 2008. Refunds are not given if your family's plans change. Fees collected may be applied to a different week on a space available basis.

Extended Day Child Care

Fees for extended day before and after camps are:

Half-day (AM or PM)	\$55
Both AM and PM	\$90

The extended day fees must be paid in full prior to the start of the camp session. Registration for extended day is included on the summer application form. Late fees will be assessed if pick-up is not by 6:00 p.m.

Cost for late pick-up will be \$2.00/minute payable to the staff person on duty at the time of pick-up.
